

WORLD LANGUAGE ENHANCED DIPLOMA APPLICATION

Students earning an enhanced diploma in World Languages have a genuine interest in languages. All students must **submit verification of grades (unofficial transcript) with the application**. Students should maintain a 3.5 GPA in the languages classes and a 3.0 overall GPA. The World Language Enhanced Diploma will have two options.

Option 1: Students can take 3 years of languages (or 3 classes if they are taking 2 languages in the same year) throughout their **10 – 12th grade years** AND complete the required additional activities.

Option 2: Students can reach level 4 or AP with a minimum of 2 years in **10 – 12th grades** AND complete the required additional activities.

ADDITIONAL COMPONENT: Students must accumulate 100 points outside of class during 10 – 12th grade years.
