What are the needs of teachers? Pacing guides, common assessments.

-Not a lot of measurements related to students.

Goal #2: Measurements are made using Sage Data. Pre-Act, ACT scores, paying for substitutes

Goal #3: What to do if students don't learn?

- See anecdotal data from math information.

Goal #4: What do we do to extend learning?

- Support after school classes.
- Measurement by number of students in each program.
- Example: Academic Decathlon: Invite average kids too, use the Trust/Land funds to help with State Competition in St. George. Science Olympiad can use Trust/Land funds.

After school participation for ACT's L.A. -148, Science-157. Math-217.

Use of a spreadsheet for 54 mobile labs is approximately \$10,000 with the cart. There are forty Chrome Books in each cart. Four years is the average duration for a Chrome Book. Remaining funds will be used for Mini-grants for teachers.

### **Proposal Draft**

Goal 1: Language Arts-Reading, Writing, How, Measurement- Professional Development focused on teaching strategies, received a lot of attention. Increase enrollment in Language Arts by 3-5%. Maintain composite score of 21.7.

Goal 2: Math- Focus on RTI for next year, increase ACT from 20.7 to 21.7.

Goal 3: Science- Move from 40% of students reaching the ACT to 50% reaching Benchmark on 2020 ACT Administration.

- Alternate: Increase predictive Pre-ACT score by .5 on March 2020 by Administration of ACT.
- Alternate: Increase whole school composite.

Goal 4: Social Studies- Pre-ACT increase 21.6 to 22.1.

Goal 5: Credit Recovery (Amy Goodrich): Increase make-up credits from 312 to 362.  
Over haul Riverton Highs packets to online standard based curriculum for Graduation Action Plan (GAP).
