### **Land Trust Budget Review**

More student focused instead of teacher focused. Use Google Classroom/SMART Goals.

- Help build quarterly goals for Pre-ACT, by using Trust Land Reports.
- Data is delayed for ACT- funding is helpful for the Pre-ACT.
- Writing is not recorded for ACT.
- Focus on Benchmarks on ACT results.

Add Math/Literacy teacher/coaches to work with teachers on Tier 1 instruction with students. Literacy/Math coaches are valuable in the secondary classroom.

Most students (89%) enjoy having another teacher in the classroom (RTI is hard to measure).

Need more PLC time, which kids are struggling? Need to carve more time out for PLC.

Senator Milner has a Bill that will become a student success program that will focus on teacher effectiveness.

### **Proposal Draft**

#### **Goal 1 Language Arts**

Skills that are a measurable standard from the ACT. By one-point increase from previous year, on each skill.

#### **Goal 2 Math**

Math functions: Math screener purchase, how do we want to test it?

Focus on secondary 2 next year. Align RTI Teachers with 2 different teachers (strategically). Continue ACT Prep after school, possibly do an ACT –Prep quarter class during school hours.

### **Goal 3 Science**

Hardest part of ACT, but reading graphs was easy.

### **Goal 4 Social Studies**

Read primary document skills, work on assessments as pre/post.

### **Goal 5 Credit Recovery (Amy Goodrich)**

Graduation Action Plan (GAP) General Ed., study skills. Each counselor has 12 students to be in Gap class.

### **Miscellaneous**

Blended learning class half on-line and half in class setting to take tests.

Arena scheduling starts in March 2019 for Fall 2020 enrollment.

Counseling Center had great attendance by parents for PCCR's.

Hope Walk: had 100 more participants than last year, with the support of city and community involvement.
